**Exclusions**

No eligible project is being excluded from the FL-501 FY16 HUD-CoC Program Competition Application.

**Reallocation Project**

The Coordinated Entry Reallocation Project includes \$40,000 from UNITY Information Network and \$38,160 from the HOME3 project. Budget reviews of both projects found both projects were underspending and could maintain current levels of service with a reduction in funding. Therefore the funding is being reallocated to an allowable new project through reallocation.

**Project Priority Listing with Tiers**

The above inclusion list is **NOT** the Project Priority Listing. The FY16 HUD-CoC Program Competition NOFA states a factor in the Collaborative Application to receive maximum points for the Ranking and

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Selection process is that all parts of the CoC Consolidated Application, including the Priority Listing with all project applications accepted and ranked or rejected, and all attachments that will be submitted to HUD, be posted a minimum of 2 days before the application submission deadline. The Collaborative Application must also notify CoC members, community members and key stakeholders of the posting.

THHI, as the Collaborative Applicant, and as stated in Addendum 2 of THHI's 2016 Universal RFP, will post all parts of the FY16 Collaborative Application in draft form to the THHI website ([www.THHI.org](http://www.THHI.org)) by 5 p.m. on August 30, 2016. At such time of the posting, THHI will open a Community Comment Period. During this comment period, CoC members, community members and key stakeholders are invited to review all parts of the FY16 Collaborative Application and provide written feedback, via email sent to [info@THHI.org](mailto:info@THHI.org). The Community Comment Period will end at 5 p.m. on September 6, 2016. On September 8 2016, the THHI Board of Directors will make the final decision regarding the Project Priority Listing and Collaborative Application. THHI will post to its website the final approved Collaborative Application to the THHI website immediately prior to its final submission to HUD.
