Project Priority Listing with Tiers

The above inclusion list is **NOT** the Project Priority Listing. The FY17 HUD-CoC Program Competition NOFA states a factor in the Collaborative Application to receive maximum points for the Ranking and Selection process is that all parts of the CoC Consolidated Application, including the Priority Listing with all project applications accepted and ranked or rejected, and all attachments that will be submitted to HUD, be posted a minimum of 2 days before the application submission deadline. The Collaborative Application must also notify CoC members, community members and key stakeholders of the posting.

On September 11 2017, the THHI Board of Directors was scheduled to make the final decision regarding the Project Priority Listing and Collaborative Application; however, due to hurricane Irma, this date will be rescheduled as soon as time permits, hopefully with an extension from HUD. THHI, as the Collaborative Applicant, and as stated in Addendum 1 of THHI's 2017 Universal RFP, will then post all parts of the final approved FY17 Collaborative Application to the THHI website (www.THHi.org) immediately prior to its final submission to HUD on September 28, 2017.
