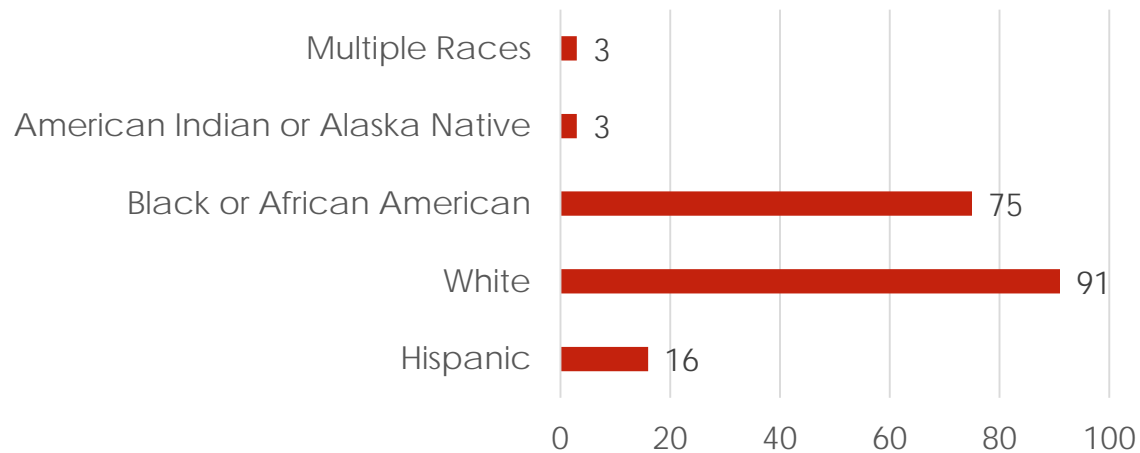

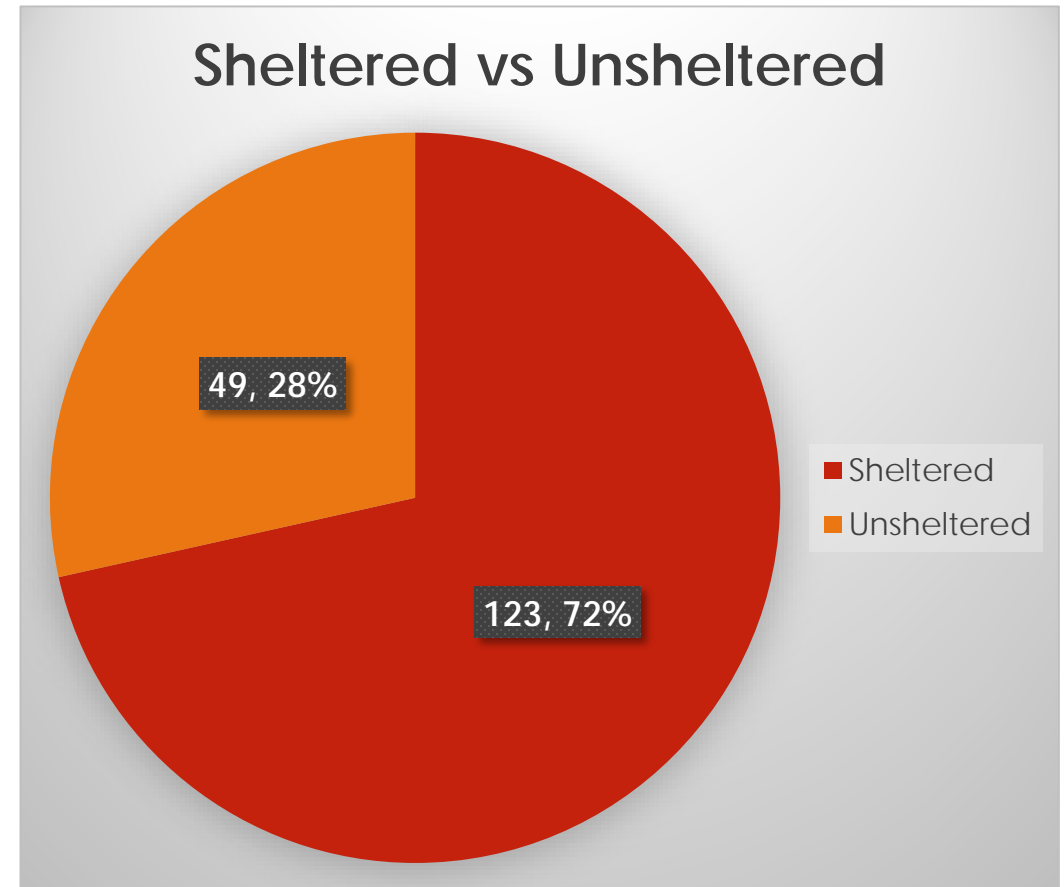

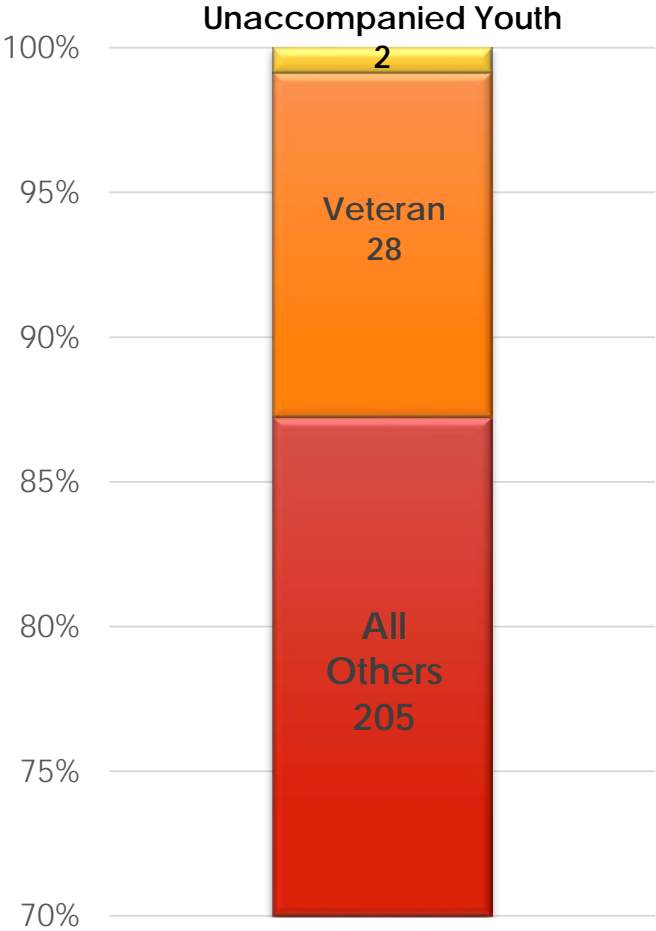

# CHRONIC HOMELESSNESS

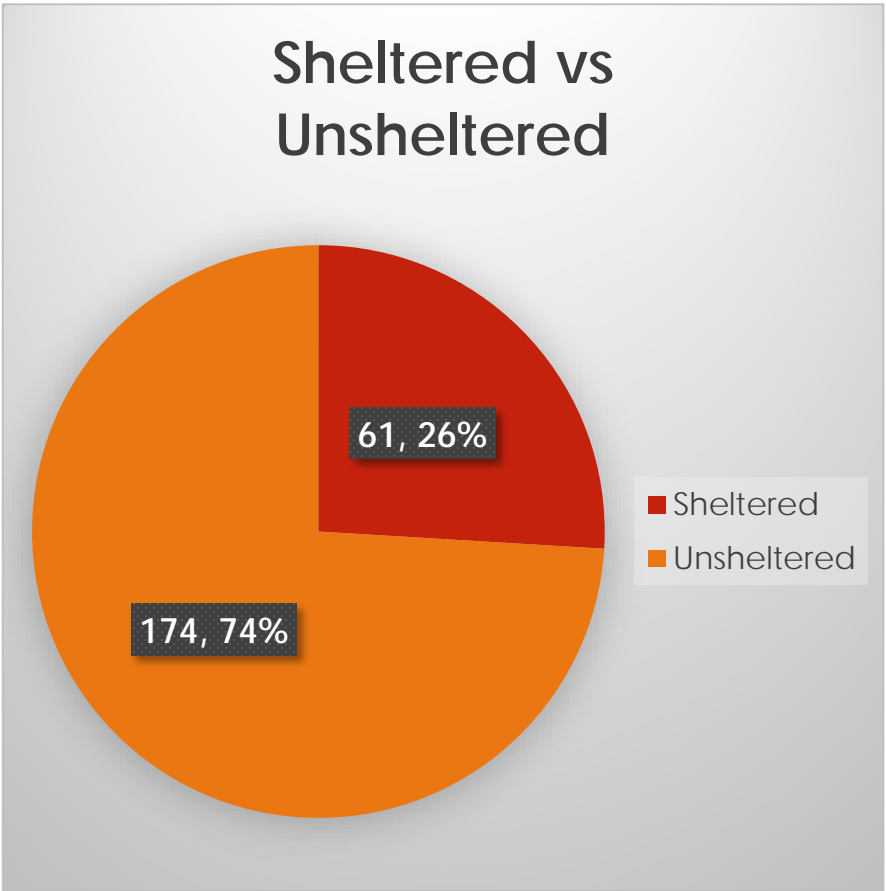

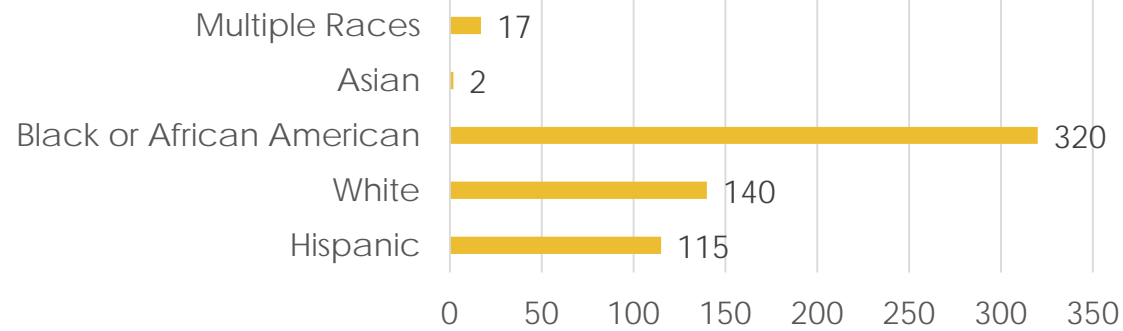

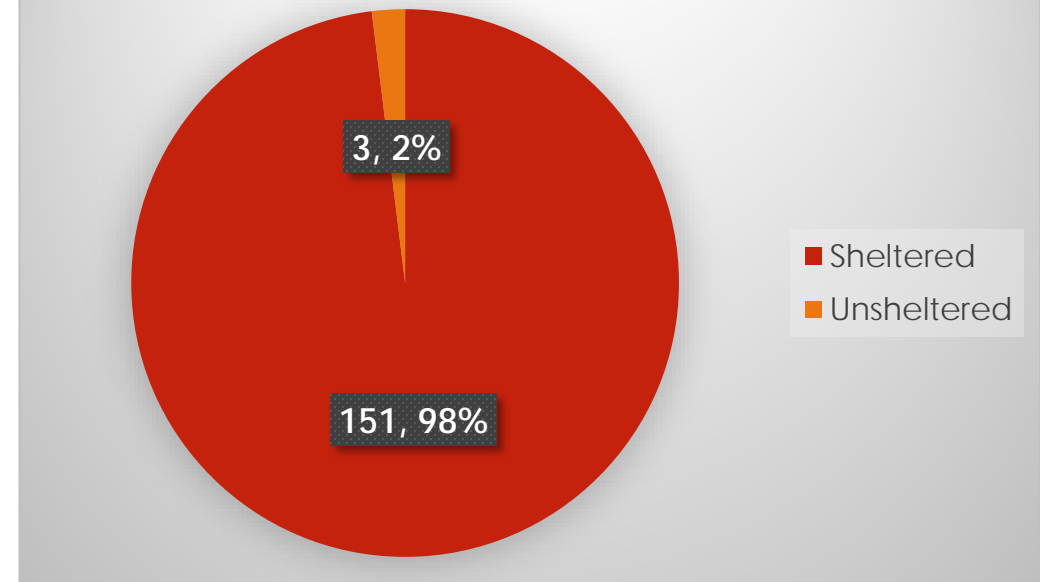

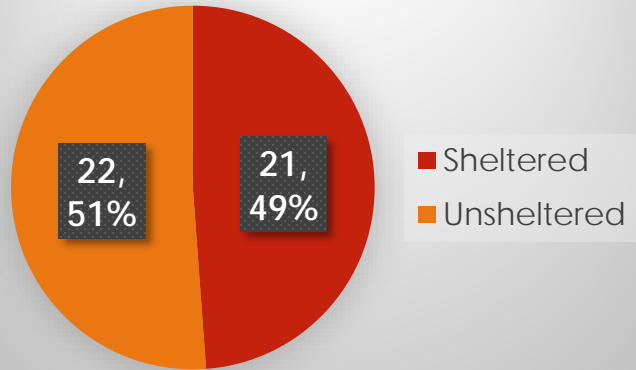

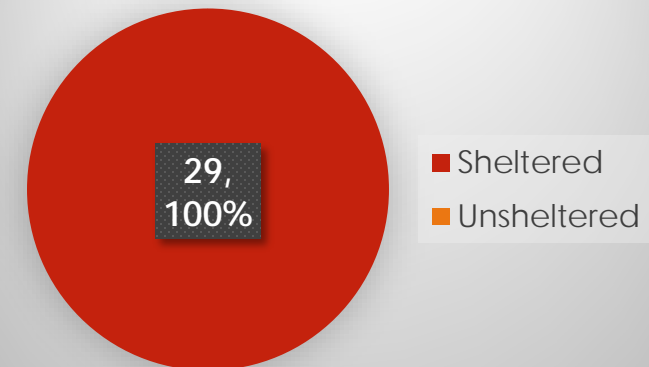

- All Parenting Youth surveyed were Female

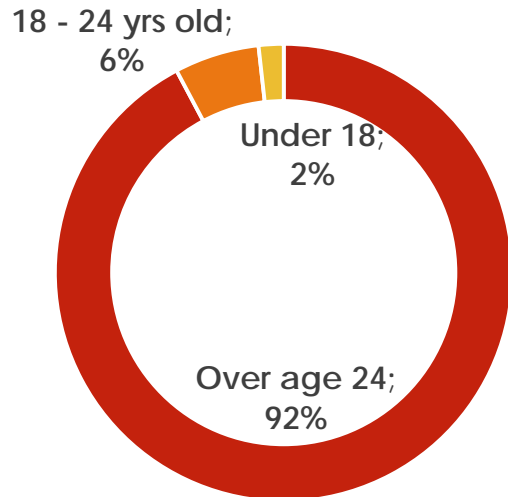

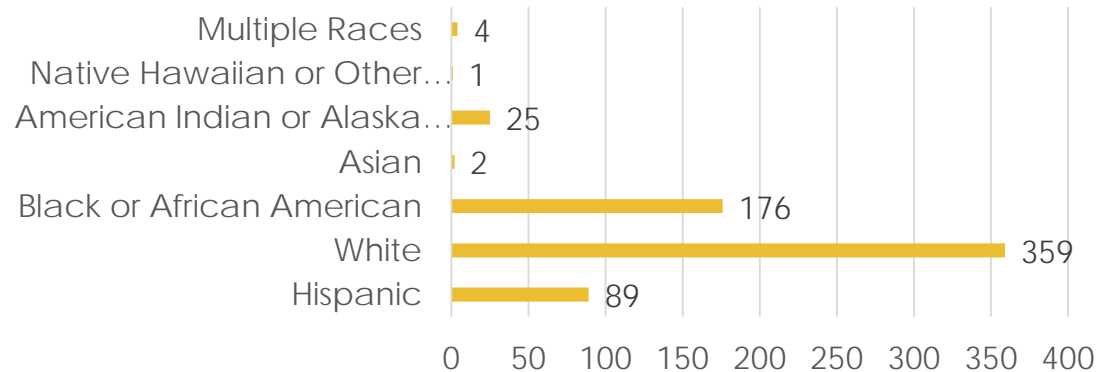

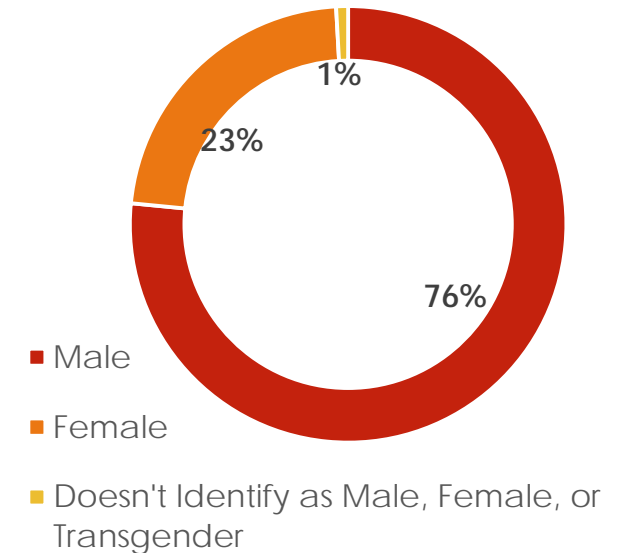
## Age Breakdown
