

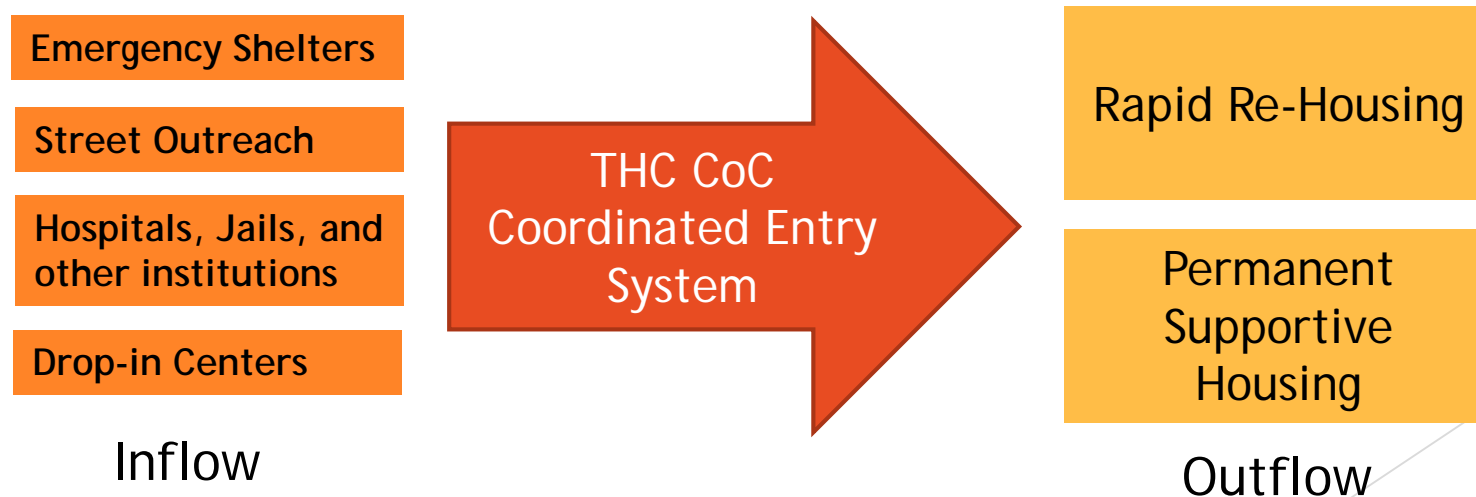


System Performance: Inflow

November 2, 2017

What is inflow?

- ▶ Persons entering our system of homeless assistance services.
- ▶ Includes persons newly identified as homeless, returned to homelessness from housing, and persons returned from being inactive in the system.
- ▶ This can give us an idea of how many persons our system should have capacity to serve to effectively end homelessness.
- ▶ Focusing on prevention before someone enters our system can help reduce the inflow for a community.

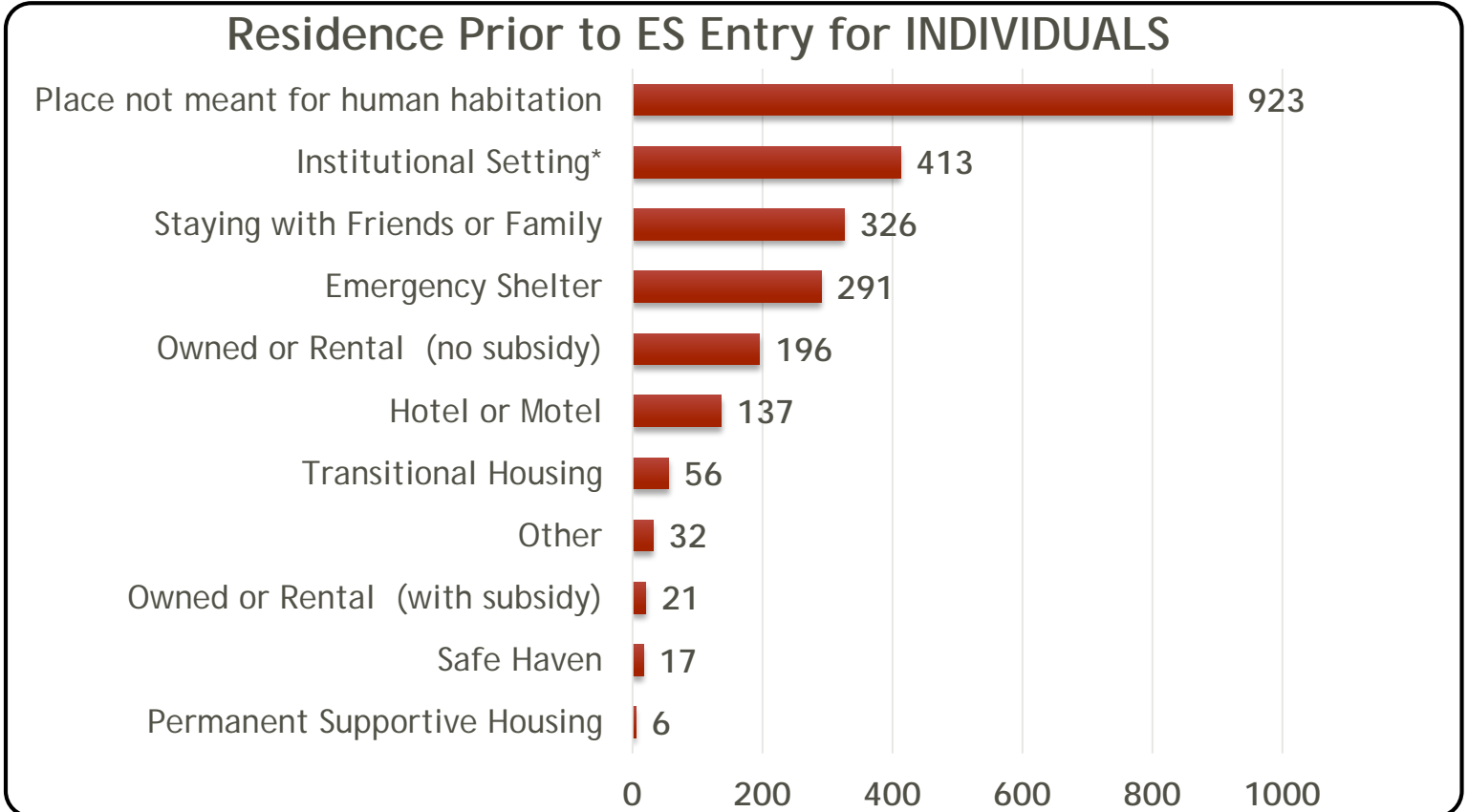


Number of Persons Accessing Emergency Shelter

- ▶ Reporting Date Range: 10/1/2016 to 9/30/2017
- ▶ Unduplicated number of persons: 3,451
- ▶ Persons in Households *without* Children: 2433
- ▶ Adults in Households with Children: 365
- ▶ Children in Households with Children: 653

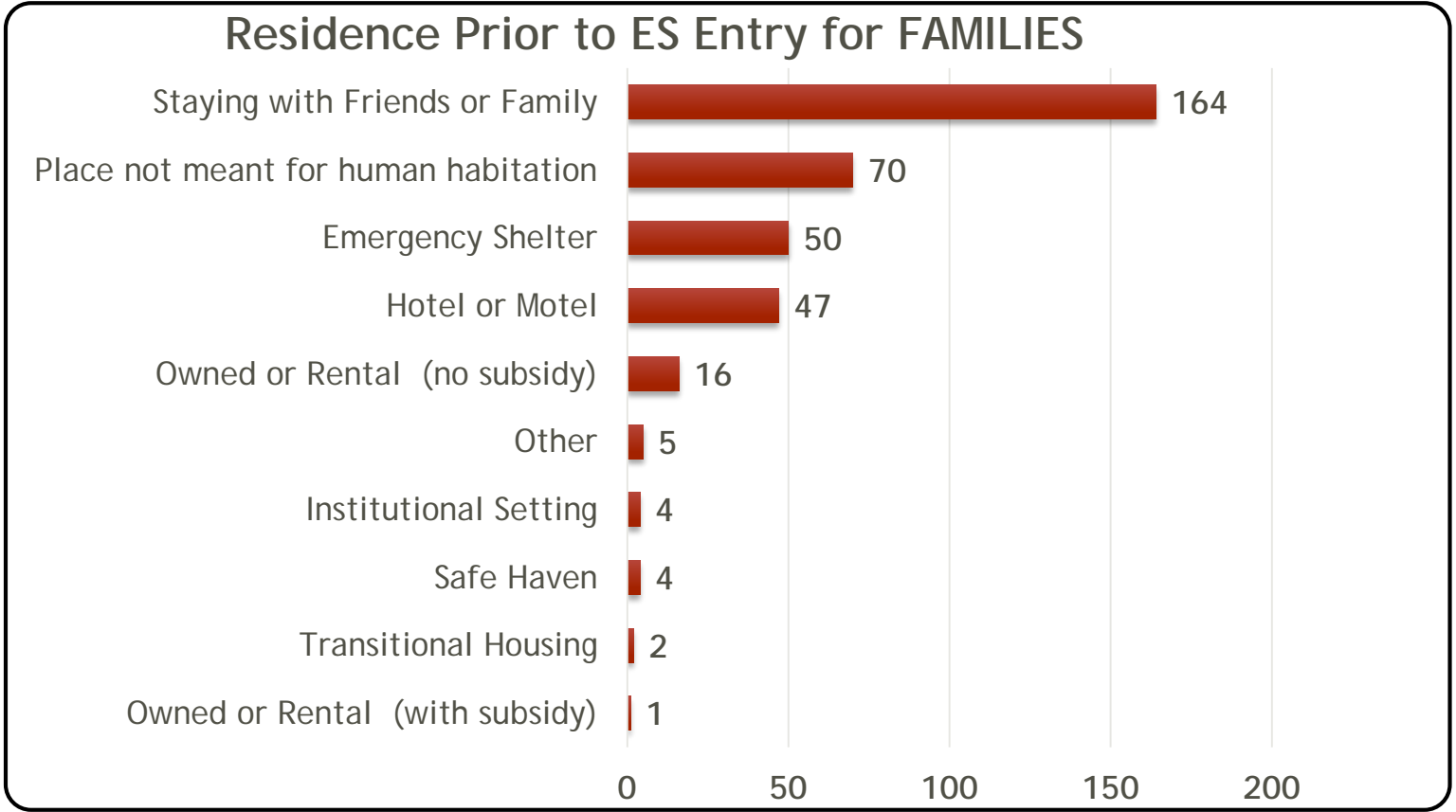
