- ▶ **Annual Homeless Assessment Report (AHAR)**
- ▶ Looks at number & characteristics of people who use homeless services and their patterns of use
- ▶ Report to U.S. Congress on homelessness
- ▶ Central resource for national data on homelessness
- ▶ Data is reported for all persons and veterans

WHAT IS THE AHAR?

- ▶ Date Range for 2017 submission – 10/1/2016 to 9/30/2017
- ▶ Emergency Shelter, Transitional Housing and Permanent Supportive Housing that use HMIS are included
- ▶ Demographics, household make up and size, length of stay, utilization rates, and data quality
- ▶ Data must meet data quality thresholds to be included in the AHAR
