

**FL-501 CoC Notice to Project Applicants of Inclusion/Exclusion
for the FY18 HUD-CoC Program Competition**

In accordance with the FY18 HUD-CoC Program Competition NOFA that all project applicants must be notified no later than 15 days (*September 3, 2018*) before the FY18 application deadline (*September 18, 2018*) of whether their project application(s) “will be accepted and ranked on the CoC Priority Listing, rejected or reduced.”

The Tampa Hillsborough Homeless Initiative (THHI), as the lead agency and collaborative applicant for the Tampa/Hillsborough County CoC, hereby issues, on August 31, 2018, this Notice to Project Applicants of inclusion / exclusion for the FY18 HUD-CoC Program Competition NOFA.

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Exclusions (Rejected)

No eligible project submitted to the CoC is being excluded from the FL-501 FY18 HUD-CoC Program Competition Application.

Application Amounts - Requested vs. Included (Reduced or Increased)

- **Renewals** - All 13 renewal project applications are being submitted at their requested annual renewal demand amount.
- **New Projects** - Agencies eligible to compete for funding available for new projects created through reallocations, Bonus and DV Bonus were given parameters under which to complete their application for the purposes of scoring. All non-coordinated entry projects were provided a reference amount of \$350,000 to set a level scoring field, with the understanding that the final amount determination would be made after scoring and a strategic review of the requests to the need and amounts available (in the various funding categories).
 - **Reallocated** - Alpha House of Tampa’s RRH for Families project application was the highest scoring new project application and was selected for the largest non-DV bonus amount that corresponds to the amount available through reallocation. This alignment resulted in a reduction from \$379,728 requested to \$334,282, which is the full amount of reallocated funding available.
 - **Bonus** – Two project applications were selected for submission as Bonus funding projects.
 - *Catholic Charities’ Hillsborough Pathways Expansion* project was the second highest score new project application and was selected to receive a portion of the eligible Bonus amount. The initial application request was decreased from \$350,000 to \$235,491. This

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reduction was based on the strategic decision of the amount needed for the expanded coordinated entry project.

- *THHI – Coordinated Entry, Phase 2* project was selected for a portion of the Bonus funding to continue our community’s efforts to implement an effective and efficient coordinated entry system, a key system component. The initial application request of \$132,000 was increased to \$185,718 based on funding needed to have at least a dedicated person working on each of the key subpopulations.
- DV Bonus – The Spring of Tampa Bay and Alpha House of Tampa’s Joint TH-RRH project, Peace Village, requested amount of \$558,295 was increased to maximize our CoC’s request to the total available DV Bonus amount of \$702,015.
