

Background

- \$4.6 million awarded FL-501 / Tampa Hillsborough County CoC
- THHI is Grantee
- Coordinated Community Plan (CCP) completed and approved by HUD
 - with YYA and community partner input
 - Identified community needs and housing/service projects
- During the Universal RFP cycle in the Spring, no proposals were able to be selected for YHDP funding
- THHI completed project applications based on CCP to not lose funding
- This RFA for agencies to apply to operate the YHDP projects

Who Can Be Served by the YHDP Funded Projects

For all project types, the eligible population are youth and young adults (YYA), ages 16 through 24, who fall into Category 1, 2, or 4 of HUD's homeless definitions:

- Category 1 are literally homelessness (e.g., living in unsheltered location, place not meant for human habitation, emergency shelter);
- Category 2 are at imminent risk of homelessness (e.g., staying temporarily with family or friends but must leave within 14 days); or
- Category 4 are fleeing or attempting to flee violence (DV, human trafficking).

Includes (but not limited to): pregnant and parenting youth, youth that have aged / will be aging out of foster care, exiting institutions/other systems of care with no residence to return, LGBTQ+, runaways

- funding amount represents a 2-year amount, with a 30-month grant term
- funding is renewable as an annual, 12-month term
- admin funding amount listed for each project (in the project description section) will be divided equally between THHI and the selected sub-grantee

We expect to award each project type to a single agency and reserve the right to select more than 1 agency per project if additional applications are received and funding sufficient to allow for more than one agency.

Project Descriptions

THIS RFA is for the Projects as submitted to and approved by HUD

- Detail information, for each project, was included in the RFA information
- Budgets <u>cannot</u> be changed
 - Budgets had to align with HUD's requirement that at least 50% of the total YHDP award was allocated to direct housing costs
 - Rental assistance, utility deposits, utility payments, application and admin fees
- There are many additional eligible costs than under regular 'CoC' funding
 - These are included and described in the Project Descriptions pages

ALL Youth (YHDP Funded) Projects MUST BE / Include:

- Low Barrier (very limited requirements, if any for entry/enrollment, on going eligibility)
- Housing First / Focused at all Levels of Service
- Welcoming and Affirming of Everyone:
 - All Races
 - All Ethnicities
 - LGBTQ+ (Genders and Sexualities)
 - All Faiths
- Adheres to HUD's Equal Access Rule
- Youth Voice / Choice

ALL Youth (YHDP Funded) Projects MUST BE / Include:

- Utilizes the following Service Models
 - Positive Youth Development (PYD)
 - Trauma Informed Care (TIC)
 - Projects must include educational partnerships, employment connections, and opportunities for community integration and permanent connections.
- Use the Coordinated Entry System
- Enter accurate data in UNITY (HMIS)
- Patriciate in required Continued Quality Improvement (CQI) Plan
- Work with the Youth Action Board to include with hiring processes/decisions

Who Can Apply

Private nonprofit organizations that meet the following:

- a 501(c)(3) certification*; and
- be registered and in good standing in the State of Florida with a current filing with the Secretary of State, Division of Corporations; and
- have no active exclusions indicated on the entity's SAM.Gov listing
- Good governance structure to meet federal requirements
- *Faith Based Organizations (e.g., churches) registered nonprofit organization in the State of Florida, without a 501(c)(3) certification are still eligible to apply
- Organizations <u>DO NOT</u> have to be an Active CoC member or currently participating in the CoC and/or the Unity Information Network (HMIS) to apply for funding

How to Apply

All YHDP RFA Applications with narratives must be received by 3:00 PM on Friday, November 1 via email to Weikell.org.

Submission Packet must include

- Completed and Signed Application (2 pages)
- Completed Narrative Responses (not to exceed 10 pages)

Narrative Responses Format:

- Single Space pages
- Format pages to accommodate 8-1/2 X 11-inch pages
- All margins should be 1 inch
- Use 12-point, Times New Roman
- No more than one page of text may be placed on one sheet of paper, i.e. you may not shrink pages to get two or more on a page. Shrunken pages or pages where a reduced font is used will not be reviewed by the reviewers and information provided in this fashion will not be used for scoring purposes.
- The use of tables/charts is allowable as part of the narrative submission pages, but do not format narratives into columns. Pages with text in columns will not be reviewed by the reviewers and information provided in this fashion will not be used for scoring purposes.
- All pages should be numbered
- Reviewers will only review the first 10 pages of narrative responses. Narratives contained on pages beyond page 10 will not be reviewed or used for scoring purposes
