
TAMPA/HILLSBOROUGH COUNTY COC 2024 HOMELESS POINT-IN-TIME COUNT




The Continuum of Care conducts a thorough count of the homeless population to measure the extent of homelessness every year, and the 2024 Annual Point-in-Time Count took place on February 22nd. Thanks to our amazing community partners and volunteers, our CoC was able to sample parts of the county and extrapolate a valid estimation of how many homeless neighbors we have in our community.



Sheltered and Unsheltered






Subpopulations**

The number of people 62+ years experiencing homelessness has doubled since 2019



2024 PIT Count Heat Map


