

WHAT IS THE POINT-IN-TIME COUNT?

- One day statistically reliable event
- Takes place annually across the nation
- Unduplicated Count of Sheltered and Unsheltered individuals and families experiencing homelessness
- Provides a snapshot of persons experiencing homelessness "on an average night" in Hillsborough
 County
- Keep in mind: the primary limitation of the PIT Count is undercounting; it is nearly impossible to count all persons experiencing homelessness in one day.


POINT-IN-TIME COUNT: ACROSS THE YEARS





- Overall downward trend in persons experiencing homelessness on an average night in Hillsborough County
- 16% (246 person) increase between 2017 and 2018, was caused by the 2017 Hurricane season.
 - 20% of persons in shelter (10% of all homeless persons) on the night of the PIT Count became homeless due to the 2017 Hurricane season.


OVERALL PIT COUNT DEMOGRAPHICS










SUBPOPULATIONS AND HIGHLIGHTS
















