One key indicator of an efficient system:

Making Homelessness Rare:

Homelessness is anomalous and seldom occurs.

Local benchmark has not yet been set.

Metric 5 - What does it measure?

- Number of people entering the homeless system through **homeless projects** with **no prior enrollments** within the **last 2 years**.

- Number of persons entering through **ES, SH, TH, or PH** with no prior enrollments.

Metric 5.2 – Change over time

Number of people who entered ES, SH, TH, PH, with no prior enrollments within two years.

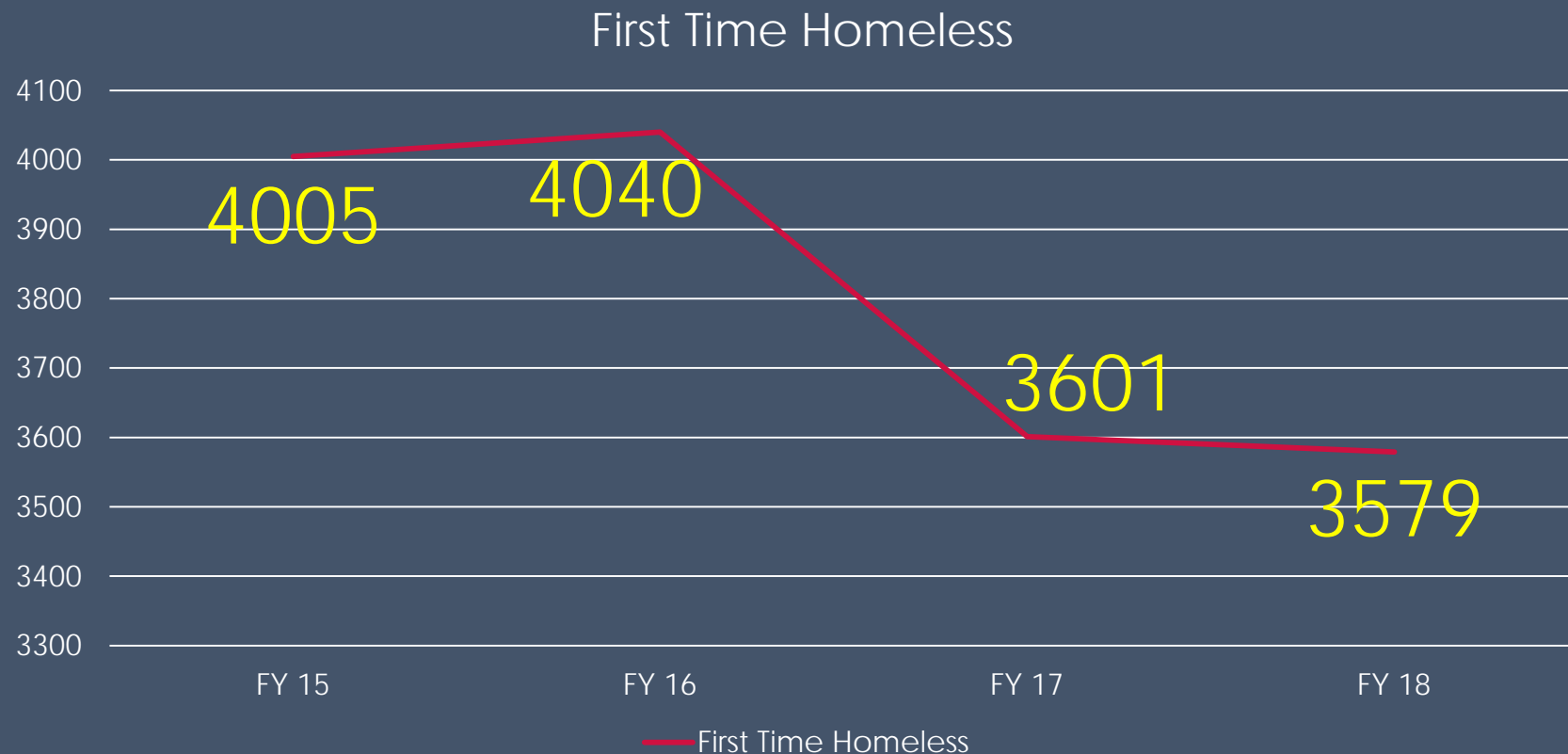

What does this mean?

- ▶ The goal is to make homelessness **rare**, meaning that we want this number to **DECREASE**.



Percent decrease since FY 15

Limitations:

- Only looks at project enrollments in 4 projects types
- The cut-off period is for only 2 years
 - Matches other system performance measures
 - Can narrow our results
